



BOS **ARTHROPLASTY FELLOWSHIP**



- This is the first year a fellowship under the aegis of the Bombay Orthopaedic Society has been proposed.
- This arthroplasty fellowship is under the mentorship of Dr. Mohan Desai and is at the KEM Hospital in Mumbai. The duration of the fellowship is 6 weeks.
- The qualification for the applicant will be a MS or a DNB degree and the candidate should be minimum of 1 year following the qualification.
- A stipend of 70,000 Rs. will be paid to cover the fellows expenses for the same for the duration of 6 weeks.
- The fellow will maintain a log book, will be allowed to assist surgeries performed by all units.
- He will submit a report at the end of the fellowship and also present his report and experience at the WIROC for 10 mins.
- The proposed duration is from the 1st of July to the 15th August 2024.
- The candidate must apply to the BOS Secretary and the subcommittee for the fellowship will vet the applications and select an appropriate candidate.
- The candidate will get to attend the Basic arthroplasty course free of cost this year.

BEST TREATISE AWARD







GENERAL GUIDELINES

At WIROC 2024, the organizers wish to encourage more delegates to present their work. With this in mind, abstracts can be submitted for submission in 10 broad categories. The best abstract in every category will be selected for presentation at the Masalawala Best paper session.

RULES

- The deadline for submission of abstracts in any category is **September 30**th.
- Abstract submission can ONLY be done through the WIROC 2024 website wiroc.in
- Only registered delegates are allowed to submit abstract.
- The same paper cannot be submitted for presentation in two different categories.
- · A delegate can make only 1 presentation in each category.
- Only the lead author of the paper can make a scientific presentation at WIROC 2024. Presenting author and no one else from the team gets a certificate for presentation.
- The names of authors and the lead author cannot be changed after submission.
- Please do not mention name of author or institution anywhere in the abstract or else, it will mean automatic disqualification.
- The submitted scripts will be reviewed by a panel of experts in a blinded and coded fashion; WIROC 2024 Scientific Committee will intimate the delegate about the acceptance or rejection of the paper.
- The decision of the scientific committee is final regarding selection of your abstract for presentation at the conference.
- The WIROC 2024 Committee reserves the right to withdraw a paper at any time.
- The WIROC 2024 Committee has the full authority to decide or change the category of papers.

CRITERIA FOR DISQUALIFICATION

Automatic disqualification occurs if:

- Disclosure of author(s) name(s) or affiliation(s) directly or indirectly anywhere in the text of the paper.
- · Previously published study.
- Papers previously presented in WIROC.
- · Plagiarized / doctored study.

STEPS FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Log on to the WIROC 2024 website wiroc.in
- Click on Abstracts.
- · Read the general guidelines.
- Click on the category in which you want to submit the abstract.
- Read the guidelines for abstract submission in that category.
- Now upload your abstract / video.
- Once it is uploaded, then press the submit button on the screen.
- Only, if you get a dialogue box on the screen that your "Abstract has been submitted successfully" has your abstract been successfully uploaded.

FREE PAPER PODIUM PRESENTATION

Scientific research that you have conducted can be presented as Free Papers. If the paper is selected, then you will get an opportunity to make a podium presentation of your work at WIROC 2024.

The reviewers of the Free Papers score the papers based on various criteria. If your paper is amongst the 6 best papers scored by the reviewers, your paper will be automatically selected for competing in the Masalawala Best Paper session. Once selected for Masalawala Best Paper Session, you are required to submit full paper along with master chart within one week. Not submitting Full Paper & Master chart within stipulated time will result in disqualification of the paper from Masalawala Best Paper Session.

RULES

- The deadline for submission of abstracts is September 30th.
- Submit Abstract (400 words) in plain text format.
- The abstract should be structured as title, introduction, materials & methods, results and conclusions. It should include five keywords.
- Indicate which one of the categories the paper may be included:
- Arthroscopy & Sports Medicine (Shoulder / Knee)
- Joint Replacement (Hip / Knee / Shoulder)
- Trauma & Reconstructive Surgery (Upper Limb / Lower Limb / Pelvi Aectabulam)
- Tumour
- Foot & Ankle
- · Infections & Metabolic
- · Paediatric Ortho
- Spine
- Hand
- Miscellaneous
- It is mandatory for the author/s to submit on demand a Master chart of study data to WIROC 2024 Scientific
 Committee. The master chart should be verified and countersigned by the Head of Department in cases where the
 work has been done in a teaching institute or when the manuscript is a multicenter study. Failure to produce the
 Master chart may invite disqualification.
- Full text submission guidelines: The author/s should submit the full text of the abstract within one week of the intimation of acceptance of the manuscript. It has to be a Word document and divided into Introduction, materials and methods, Results, Discussion and conclusion. The full text should be a maximum 4000 words excluding the references and figure legends. The referencing should be standard Vancouver style. A maximum of six figures and 2 tables can be added and should be embedded in the word document. The manuscript should be entirely blinded and there should be no mention of the author names, affiliations, etc.

VIDEO PODIUM PRESENTATION

At WIROC 2024 we will be running an OPEN Theatre where videos made by delegates will be presented by the delegates. The videos must highlight routine or innovative procedures, newer technique or even examination of a patient.

The videos will be reviewed by our reviewers. The 4 best videos will be selected for presentation in the Best Video Competition at WIROC 2024. The rest of the selected videos will get a presentation during the open theatre session.

RULES

- Video & Abstract submission deadline is September 30th.
- · Both a written abstract and a video must be submitted for evaluation.
- Written abstract must explain what the video is aiming to demonstrate (150 words).
- Manufacturer's demo videos are not allowed and will mean automatic disqualification.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE VIDEO FILE ARE AS FOLLOWS

- · File format: .mp4
- · Duration: Maximum 8 minutes
- The 16:9 widescreen aspect ratio is preferred. Please edit in the native format of your camera if you can. 4:3 is acceptable. However, please do not "stretch" your video.
- The maximum video size allowed as an abstract is 500 MB
- Patient Privacy: Identifying information, including patients' names, initials, or hospital numbers, must not appear. This typically happens in pre and post-operative radiographs, and MRIs. Written consent must be obtained from each person appearing in the work.

INTERESTING CASE / INNOVATIVE IDEA PODIUM PRESENTATION

An interesting case / series of cases either because it is an unusual presentation or an unexpected outcome or innovatively treated is ideal for presentation during this session. If selected, you will get a podium presentation to highlight your case. The best presentations will be selected for the BEST CASE session at WIROC 2024.

RULES

- The deadline for submission of abstracts is **September 30**th.
- Submit Abstract (300 words) in English in plain text format.
- The abstract should be structured as title, introduction, materials & methods, results and conclusions. It should include five keywords.
- Submission of abstract is online only. Details of submission process in general guidelines.

PRESENT YOUR PUBLICATION

This is a new session in which you can present your published work about which you can be proud of. The published work must not be presented in any previous WIROC or at National / International / Conferences.

RULES

- The article has to be published in a pubmed indexed journal between July 1st, 2023 to December 31st, 2024
- Abstract, full text pdf as well as pubmed citation should be submitted.
- · Submission of all the details will be online only on wiroc.in

E-POSTER SESSION

An E-poster is a short powerpoint presentation detailing your scientific work. At WIROC 2024, your PPT will be uploaded onto computers at the conference venue and will be open for viewing by delegates during the course of the conference.

Judges will select the 5 best posters. The lead author of these posters will get an opportunity to make a 2 mins presentation to the judges at the poster display area. There will be an award for Best Poster.

All posters carry the same weightage as Free Papers. Poster presenters will receive an acknowledgement certificate from WIROC 2024.

RULES

- The deadline for submission of abstracts is September 30th.
- Submit Abstract (300 words) in English in plain text format.
- The full paper should be structured as title, introduction, materials & methods, results and conclusions. It should include five keywords.
- There is a prize for the Best Poster.

YOUNG SURGEON'S FORUM

If you are a young turk (<45 years of age on or before 31st December 2024), who is doing some outstanding clinical / basic science work that you wish to showcase at WIROC 2024, this is your chance. If selected for this prestigious award, you will get a podium presentation during the Plenary Session at WIROC 2024. Only original work conducted in India can be submitted for consideration.

RULES

- Only full papers will be considered for the award.
- Submit Full Paper in English in plain text format.


